**Monthly Stablefords:**

£5 Entry

- £2 for Birdies on par 3's only
- £1 Carry Over
- £2 Prize money (1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> places – 60%, 40%,)

Best **five** scores over the season:

- 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> places: 50%, 30%, 20%

**Monthly Medals**

No Entry Fee

- Gold Medal for winner
- Silver Medal for runner up

**Majors (except Club Championship):**

No Entry Fee

- Winner presented with club trophy.

**Club Championship:**

No Entry Fee

- Best 36-hole Gross score: Crystal prizes for 1<sup>st</sup> 2<sup>nd</sup> & 3<sup>rd</sup>
- Best 36-hole Nett score: Crystal prizes for 1<sup>st</sup> 2<sup>nd</sup> & 3<sup>rd</sup>
- Winners of best, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> best Gross scores **cannot** also win a Nett prize

**Winter Series Roll Ups**

- £1 Prize fund for best **six** scores
  - £2 Any 2 on a par 3
  - £2 Prize money – 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> only (60/40)

**Turkey Trot**

Yellow tees of the day + Yellow stroke index  
Stableford scoring  
Full handicap (95% applied automatically)

**Four-Ball Better Ball**

White tees + White stroke index  
Strokeplay scoring  
85% of course handicap

**Greensome Cup**

White tees + White stroke index  
Stableford scoring  
Lower handicap x 0.6 + higher handicap x 0.4

**Greensome Medal**

White tees  
Strokeplay scoring  
Lower handicap x 0.6 + higher handicap x 0.4

**Club Championship:**

- First day groupings to be in handicap order – 0-12/13-20/21 to 28.4
- In the event of a tie for best Gross score a sudden death playoff will take place in the following order:
  - Holes 18, 1, 2, 4, 9, 1, 2, 4, 9.....etc.
- If scores are still tied, this sequence will be replayed until a winner is decided.

The winner of the Gross Club Championship and the second and third placed players in the Gross competition will only win one prize, they cannot also win the Nett competition prizes.

### **General Competition Rules:**

- Normal dress code will be observed by all members “i.e.,” no jeans or ‘t’ shirts.
- Members must be on the tee 10 minutes prior to their tee time; failure to comply with this courtesy to other players will result in a one-shot penalty in stroke play or a two-point deduction in Stableford play.
- Failure to turn up for a competition that you have entered will result in a fine being levied against you if you have not notified the **Vice-Captain by 22.00 the day before a competition**. The fine will be as follows:
  - 1<sup>st</sup> offence - £20 and the offender will not be permitted to participate in the next Club competition.
  - 2<sup>nd</sup> & subsequent offences - £20 and the offender will not be permitted to participate in the Club’s following two competitions.
- In situations where NAPGC competitions clash with a Major competition or a monthly Stableford, these competitions will be held over a weekend. In other words, those members committed to an NAPGC competition on a Saturday, can choose to play their games on a Sunday. The winners of the competition and any share of money will be determined on completion of the competition on Sunday. The winners will be announced on the following Saturday.

### **Winter Series Roll Ups**

- Starting 14<sup>th</sup> December 2024 and running through to 29<sup>th</sup> March 2025 we will be playing the Winter Stableford Series every Saturday morning, weather permitting.
- The person who has the best six Stableford scores at the end of March will win a share of the prize pot – in the ratio 50%, 30%, 20%.
- Entry fee each week is £5. Please pay the appropriate committee member in cash on the day.
- The £5 entry fee will be divided as:
  - £1 – into “Best 6 scores” prize pot
  - £2 – for two’s, on par 3’s
  - £2 – prize money (60% - 40%)
- We will pay out for any TWO on the four par 3’s.
- We will pay out for 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> places only each week.
- The playing handicap allowance will be  $\frac{3}{4}$  of your HANDICAP INDEX as it stands on 30<sup>th</sup> November 2024
- 1<sup>st</sup> place will be cut 2 strokes from that PLAYING HANDICAP, 2<sup>nd</sup> place will be cut 1 stroke.
- The lowest score each week will get 1 stroke added to the PLAYING HANDICAP but will have to provide a bottle of wine costing a minimum of £5.
- Scorecards will not be automatically submitted to the WHS but The Committee would hope that any above average scores will be voluntarily surrendered for handicap adjustment.
- There will be a nearest-the-pin each week

## **Matchplay Knockouts**

This is predominantly a mid-week competition. Matches are to be played mid-week and only by exception, on weekends, and if agreed by all golfers. But a refusal to play at the weekend is not grounds for disqualification. Please do not enter the singles or doubles competition if you are not prepared to play midweek.

The first named golfer/pair MUST contact the opposition in good time to arrange a date for the match.

All matches are to be played by the deadlines provided. Failure to do so will result in disqualification from the competition of one or both parties. The final arbiter will be the Organiser of these competitions.

A golfer who becomes injured during the competition can be substituted but only with a golfer who has not played in the competition that year. The substitute golfer should continue to play in subsequent rounds if applicable.

Handicap allowances: Singles - 100%, Doubles – 90% of difference
